## Competition details:

- Matches will be shot to ISSF rules. There will be no equipment control but pistol and rifle weights will be available. (Also advice will be on hand if anyone wishes to talk about other competitions, equipment control, what range offices do & NSRA Bisley & Aldersley)
- The times stated when selecting details is the call to the line time this will then be followed by 15 Minutes preparation time, 15 minutes sighting time and 90 minutes match firing time.
- All matches will be shot on paper targets.
- For air pistol the competition will consist of 60 shots, 30 cards 2 shots on each.
- For air rifle the competition will consist of 60 shots, 12 strip cards 5 shots on each (1 shot per diagram).
- For sporter air rifle competitors can shoot all 60 shots and be entered into the rifle open and A-C and junior classes but the first 40 shots will be taken for the sporter class.
- For air pistol and rifle there will be an open championship class including everyone and also a junior class (Under 21) there will also be classes A- C based off shot average.
- Pistol – Class A 550 + / Class B 535 – 550 / Class C under 535
- Rifle- Class A 590 + / Class B 560 – 590 / Class C under 560
- Competitors may be moved classes if there is less than 3 competitors in a class
- For open classes there will be Gold, Silver and Bronze available.
- Average classes Gold, Silver and Bronze can be won if correct amount of competitors
